- confidently and easily speak about what matters most
- make decisions that take all the meaningful dimensions of your life into account
- stand strong in yourself in an increasing number of situations

On this one day introduction to the Map of Meaning we will firstly focus on understanding the role of meaningfulness in your life and show how this helps you to assess and plan your life. This will also increase your ability to ensure that your work/life is meaningful.

During the second half of the day we will explore ways to use the Map of Meaning to increase meaningfulness in areas that are specifically relevant to you – such as: family life, work, working with others, career planning and running your business.
